You lack confidence in your writing. Even professional writers get rejection letters - if you're new to the game, you'll likely face at least a few of these when querying agents or publishers, or when submitting work for publication in magazines. It's easy to get disheartened by this, but remember that there are people out there who read everything they can get their hands on - they might not respond to your query letter, but that doesn't mean they don't want to read your book. Keep sending off work until you do eventually receive some positive feedback! 4. You worry about how others will treat you upon publication. We live in a world where everyone's got an opinion, and if you write something that doesn't tickle someone else's fancy, you'll probably hear about it. But every bookwriter has to find his or her own place in the literary world. Your friends and family aren't likely to top the top 100 books of the year - but that doesn't mean they're not interested in your work. If you don't get any feedback from publishers or agents, then maybe send out some query letters to magazines that publish guest-ops; this isn't guaranteed, but at least it will give you another outlet for publication! 3.
